1. Short Title.	Repeals.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Christchurch Tramway District Act, 1920. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Christchurch Tramway District Amendment Act, 1939, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch Tramway District Act, 1920 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. (1) The next general election of the whole of the members of the Christchurch Tramway Board shall be held on the last Saturday in November in the year nineteen hundred and thirty-nine, and on the same day in every succeeding third year thereafter all members of the Board shall go out of office, and on every such day a fresh general election of members of the Board shall be held. General election of Board.

(2) Section eighteen of the principal Act is *and section eight of the Christchurch Tramway District Amendment Act, 1921, are hereby repealed.* Repeals.
