A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Abolition of Compulsory Vaccination in
New Zealand. Title.

WHEREAS the laws which compel all persons to have their children vaccinated, even in cases where their medical advisers are of opinion that the process is useless or dangerous, inflict great hardship upon large numbers of the community, and it is expedient that those laws should be repealed : Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Compulsory Vaccination Abolition Act, 1883.” Short Title.

2. From and after the passing of this Act all those sections of statutes providing for compulsory vaccination shall be and are hereby repealed. Compulsory vaccination abolished.
