## A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to enable the Council of the Borough of Caversham to Title. deal with the Surplus Profits of the Waterworks Account of the said Borough.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Caversham Waterworks Short Title. Account Act, 1896."

2. In the interpretation hereof, "the said account" shall mean Interpretation. 10 the separate account which the Council of the Borough of Caversham is obliged by law to keep of water-rates, water-supply, and moneys accruing from waterworks.

3. After making due provision for all sums with which the said Power to deal with account is by law charged, the Council of the Borough of Caversham 15 is hereby empowered to transfer from time to time any the surplus remaining on the thirty-first March last in the said account to the credit of the General Account of the Corporation of the said borough.
