A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Disqualification Act, 1878." Title.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend "The Disqualification Act, 1878:" Preamble.

5 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Disqualification Act 1878 Amendment Act, 1886." Short Title.

10 2. No person, if and while he is a Member of the General Assembly of New Zealand, shall, nor shall any firm in which such person has any pecuniary interest, be entitled to receive or be paid any salary or other remuneration for or in respect of any office or appointment in the gift of or made by the Governor of the colony or 15 of the Executive Council thereof, or of any officer of the Government thereof, or for or in respect of any services for or dealings with the Government of the said colony: Provided that this section shall not affect or limit the provisions of "The Disqualification Act, 1878," or disentitle any member of a Land Board constituted under "The Land 20 Act, 1885," from being refunded any actual travelling expenses. No member to accept remuneration. Proviso.
