A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to prevent Members of Parliament and others Title. from being appointed to Offices of Emolument under the Government of New Zealand.

HEREAS it is desirable to amend "The Disqualification Act, Preamble. 1870 ":

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 5 as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Disqualification Act Short Title. Amendment Act, 1876."

2. If any person shall, while he is a member of the Assembly, or Members and perwithin twelve six months after ceasing to be such member, accept any sons ceasing to be 10 office or place of profit under the Crown, he shall forfeit the sum of office. fifty pounds sterling for every week he shall hold such office or place, Penalty. with full costs of suit to any person who shall sue for the same : Provided always that nothing contained in this section shall extend or

apply to any person accepting any of the offices or places of Ministers Exceptions. 15 mentioned in the seventh section of "The Civil List Act 1863 Amendment Act, 1873," or to of the Speakers Speaker of the Legislative Council or of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, or to the Chairman of Committees in either the Legislative Council or the House of Representatives, or to the Chairman of the Public Petitions Com-

20 mittee in either the Legislative Council or the House of Representatives, or the office of Judge of the Supreme Court, or that of the Agent-General of the Colony.

3. This Act shall commence and be deemed and taken to have Act to come into commenced and come into operation from the end of the session of 25 Parliament begun and holden on the fifteenth day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six.
