A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Exemptions under "The Disqualification Act, 1878." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Disqualification Act 1878 Amendment Act, 1885." Short Title.

2. No person who at any time has been or may be appointed to the rank of Commander of the Colonial Forces in the colony, and who shall receive remuneration for his services as such, shall be thereby disqualified from being or continuing to be a member of either House of the General Assembly, anything contained in "The Disqualification Act, 1878," notwithstanding. Commander of colonial forces exempt from Disqualification Act.
