## A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to extend the Exemptions under "The Disqualification Title, Act, 1878."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Disqualification Act Short Title. 1878 Amendment Act, 1885."

2. No person who at any time has been or may be appointed to commander of the rank of Commander of the Colonial Forces in the colony, and who colonial forces exempt from Dis-10 shall receive remuneration for his services as such, shall be thereby qualification Act. disqualified from being or continuing to be a member of either House of the General Assembly, anything contained in "The Disqualification Act, 1878," notwithstanding.
