A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Acts relating to Dentists.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Dentists Acts Amendment Act, 1891."

Short Title.

2. The sixth section of "The Dentists Act, 1880," is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof it is enacted that any person being the holder of a certificate (however designated) granted by any person or body in a British possession duly empowered for that purpose, showing that the holder is entitled to practise dentistry in such possession, shall, on proof that he is of good character, and on payment of the registration fee, be entitled to be registered under "The Dentists Act, 1880," without any further examination.

Repeal of section "The Dentists Act, 1880."

The proof that the person or body granting the certificate to practise dentistry was duly empowered to do so shall lie upon the person so applying for registration in New Zealand.

3. "The Dentists Act 1880 Amendment Act, 1881," is hereby amended as follows, to wit: In line six of subsection one of section three thereof, the words "within one year" are hereby repealed.

Amendment of Act of 1881.

4. The Senate shall appoint a Board of Examiners for each of the cities of Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, and Dunedin, for the purpose of conducting examinations and granting certificates under the Dentist Acts and this Act.
