Title. Preamble. 1. A Widow to have Dower only out of Land of which the Husband died

An Act to amend the Law relating to Dower.

Title.

WHEREAS the right of a married woman to Dower out Preamble. of the Lands and Tenements of which her Husband may at any time have been seized during the coverture, occasions considerable expence and delay in the alienation of Real Estate.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand, that:—
