A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Deaths by Accidents Compensation Act, 1908. Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Deaths by Accidents Compensation Short Title. Amendment Act, 1931 (No. 2), and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Deaths by Accidents Compensation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

10 2. In assessing damages in any action, whether commenced before As to assessment of or after the passing of this Act, under the principal Act, there shall not damages under principal Act. be taken into account any sum paid or payable on the death of the cf. 8 Edw. 7, c. 7, deceased under any contract of insurance, whether made before or s. 1 after the passing of this Act, or any pension to which any person for 15 whose benefit the action is brought has any right either under any Act

of the General Assembly of New Zealand or otherwise.
