A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Dunedin City Corporation Empowering Act, Title. 1924.

WHEREAS by the Dunedin City Corporation Empowering Act, 1920, Preamble. 5 the Corporation of the City of Dunedin is empowered to construct and erect, in accordance with the plan deposited in the office of the Public Works Department at Wellington as number 49402, a dam or weir across the Waipori River at a point in such river shown on the said plan: And whereas by the Dunedin City Corporation Empowering

10 Act. 1924 (hereinafter called the said Act), the said Corporation is empowered to raise the height of the said dam or weir to one hundred and ten feet above the bed of the said river as shown on the plan deposited in the office of the Public Works Department at Wellington as number 60375, and at all times to maintain the said dam or weir

15 and to impound, collect, divert, and take away for its absolute use and benefit all the waters in the Waipori River for the purpose of generating electricity and supplying the same as motive power and for lighting and for any other purpose whatsoever: And whereas the said Corporation proposes to erect in the Waipori River a dam or weir 20 in lieu of or in addition to and below the site of the said dam or weir

mentioned in the said Act:

Title

Preamble.

1. Short Title.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

25 1. This Act may be cited as the Dunedin City Corporation short Title

Empowering Amendment Act, 1927.

2. (1) The said Corporation is hereby empowered to construct Power to construct and erect a dam or weir across the Waipori River at any point in such dam across Waipori River. river to be determined by the Corporation below the site of the said

30 dam or weir mentioned in the said Act:

Provided, however, that nothing herein shall empower the said Corporation to raise the level of the water of the said river at the site of the said dam or weir mentioned in the said Act to a greater height than one hundred and ten feet above the bed of the said river as shown on the said plan deposited in the office of the Public Works Department at Wellington as number 60375.

(2) The construction and erection of the said dam or weir shall be carried out in accordance with detail working drawings and specifications to be submitted by the said Corporation and approved

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by the Minister of Public Works.

3. The said Act shall be read and construed and take effect in all respects as if the powers and authorities hereby conferred on the said Corporation had been contained in the said Act.

4. It shall not be lawful for any person to discharge any tailings, mining debris, or waste water into the Waipori River above the said 15 dam or weir hereby authorized to be constructed and erected, or into any tributary that enters the river above such dam or weir.
