A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Dunedin District Drainage and Sewerage Act, 1900." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Dunedin District
Drainage and Sewerage Act 1900 Amendment Act, 1905"; and it
shall form part of and be read together with "The Dunedin District
10 Drainage and Sewerage Act, 1900" (hereinafter called "the principal
Act"). Short Title.

2. The Board is hereby authorised to borrow further money for
the purposes of the principal Act not exceeding in the whole the sum
of one hundred and fifty thousand pounds; and section fifty-six of
15 the principal Act shall be read and construed as if the words "three
hundred and fifty thousand pounds" had been originally inserted
therein instead of the words "two hundred thousand pounds."

3. Section forty-nine of the principal Act is hereby amended by
substituting the words "one shilling" for the word "eightpence"
20 in the seventh line paragraph (1) thereof, and by substituting the
word "sixpence" for the word "fourpence" in the tenth line para-
graph (2) thereof. Amendment of
section 49 of Act
of 1900.
