A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Dairy-produce Export Control Act, 1923. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Dairy-produce Export Control Short Title.
Amendment Act, 1924, and shall be read together with and deemed
part of the Dairy-produce Export Control Act, 1923 (hereinafter
referred to as the principal Act).

10 2. The Board established under the principal Act shall have, Board to have power

and shall be deemed at all times since its establishment to have had,
power out of its moneys to provide and carry out in New Zealand or
elsewhere any such display or exhibit of New Zealand dairy-produce
as it may deem advantageous; and also, in any manner it may
15 think fit, to advertise or give publicity to the merits, qualities, prices,
and conditions of sale of any such produce, or to promote the con-
sumption thereof; and also to do or undertake any experiment or
other act, matter, or thing which in its opinion is calculated to
20 promote or improve the quality of New Zealand dairy-produce or to
promote the trade and sale thereof, including power to act in com-
bination with the Board established under the Meat-export Control
Act, 1921-22, or any other Board that may be established to control
the sale of any other products of New Zealand, on terms of sharing
25 the costs and expenses involved in such combination in such propor-
tions or manner as the Boards concerned may agree.
