- Act, 1881." 2. An Act of the General Assembly intituled "The Distress and "Distress Act, 1868,"
- Replevin Act, 1868," is hereby repealed.

 3. It shall not be lawful for any person hereafter to distrain for No distress for rent
- to be taken. rent or arrears of rent.
- 4. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of January, 10 one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two.
