#### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Dangerous Goods Act, 1869,"  
and "The Dangerous Goods Act Amendment  
Act, 1870."  
Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Dangerous Goods Act,  
1869," and "The Dangerous Goods Act Amendment Act, 1870,"  
hereinafter called the said Acts :  
Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New  
Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Dangerous Goods  
Act Amendment Act, 1877."  
Short Title.

2. The Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council,  
declare that petroleum or any of the articles or products included  
in that expression by "The Dangerous Goods Act Amendment Act,  
1870," shall come within the provisions of the said Acts, or any one or  
more of such provisions, notwithstanding that they do not give off an  
inflammable vapour at a temperature of less than one hundred and  
ten degrees of Fahrenheit's thermometer; and may from time to time  
in like manner revoke, alter, or amend any such order. So long as  
such order shall remain in force, the articles and products therein  
mentioned shall be subject to the provisions of the said Acts, or to such  
part thereof as in such order shall be prescribed.  
Governor may declare that petroleum, &c., shall come within the provisions of the above Acts in certain cases.

3. The Governor may by such order, or from time to time by  
Order in Council, declare that the provisions of any Order in Council  
made under section two of this Act shall only apply to the parts or  
places within the colony specified in such order; and may from time  
to time in like manner revoke, alter, or amend such order.
