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A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Dairy Industry Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Dairy Industry Amendment Act, 1915, and shall form part of and be read together with the Dairy Industry Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

2. (1.) Section twenty-two of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing paragraph (d) of subsection one, and substituting the following paragraph :—

Section 22 of principal Act amended.

“(d.) Sends to any grading-store for the purpose of being graded any butter which contains more than sixteen per centum of water, or exports or attempts to export any such butter.”

(2.) Where any butter containing more than sixteen per centum of water is sent to a grading-store to be graded, the owner of such butter shall cause the same to be treated and disposed of in such manner as an Inspector may direct, or the Inspector may, at the expense of the owner, cause the same to be treated and disposed of in such manner as he thinks fit.

3. Section twenty-three of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (a) the following paragraph :—

Section 23 of principal Act amended.

“(aa.) Prescribing conditions subject to which applications for the registration of dairies may be granted, including a condition requiring the prior approval by the Minister of the site, buildings, and equipment of any dairy.”
