DESIGNATION OF DISTRICTS ACT AMENDMENT.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Designation of Districts Act, 1894."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Designation of Districts Act Amendment Act, 1895."

Short Title.

10 2. The provisions of the fourth section of "The Designation of Districts Act Amendment Act, 1894," shall extend and apply to any place where a local authority submits a new name or names for any place which the Governor for any reason deems to be unsuitable, in which event the Governor may proceed and act in like manner as he could do if the local authority had refused or neglected to submit a new name or names under the provisions aforesaid.

Governor empowered to proceed under the principal Act where local authority submits a name which is unsuitable.

15 This enactment shall be deemed to have formed part of the said Act, and to have been in force at the date of the passing thereof.
