## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to define Time in New Zealand.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Definition of Time Act, 1915.

Short Title.

2. In this Act, if not inconsistent with the context,— "New Zealand standard time" means the time corresponding

to the longitude of one hundred and seventy-two degrees thirty minutes east from Greenwich, which time is exactly eleven and a half hours in advance of Greenwich mean

"New Zealand clock time" means the time to be observed throughout New Zealand as prescribed by this Act:

"Hour of two in the morning" means that hour as deter-

mined by New Zealand standard time.

November in each year until the hour of two in the morning of the summer and winter months. first Sunday in February in each year New Zealand clock time shall 20 be one hour in advance of New Zealand standard time, and from the hour of two in the morning of the first Sunday in February in each year until the hour of two in the morning of the first Sunday in November in each year New Zealand clock time shall be the same
