A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Destitute Persons Act, 1910.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Destitute Persons Amendment Act, 1920, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Destitute Persons Act, 1910.

Short Title.

2. Forthwith after the passing of this Act an appointment shall be made under section two of the Destitute Persons Amendment Act, 1915, in respect of the Magistrate's Court in the Cities of Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, and Dunedin.
