A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Hearing in Camera of Cases Title.
under the Destitute Persons Act, 1910.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New
5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Destitute Persons Short Title.
Amendment Act, 1935, and shall be read together with

2. In all proceedings under Part II of the principal Public not to

officers of the Court and the parties and their counsel, to Court

15 presiding Magistrate shall deem necessary to the
proceedings and permit to be present:

Provided that the presiding Magistrate, either on
the application of a party or at his discretion, for
reasons peculiar to any case, may order that any or
20 all of the proceedings in that case be open to persons
generally.
