A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Dog Registration Act, 1880."

Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the law relating to the registration of dogs :

Preamble.

5 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Dog Registration Act Amendment Act, 1882."

Short Title.

10 It shall be deemed to be incorporated with "The Dog Registration Act, 1880" (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act").

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the said Act, the local authority having jurisdiction within any district may, by notification published in a newspaper having general circulation within the district, appoint the fee to be paid for the registration of any dog within such district to be such sum, not exceeding *ten* shillings and not less than *five two* shillings and *sixpence*, as the said authority shall think fit.

Registration fee to be fixed by local authority.

15 Provided that when dogs are kept for the sole purpose of the management of live stock, or for the destruction of rabbits, it shall be lawful for ~~any County Council or Highway Board~~ *such local authority* to reduce the fee for the registration of any such dog to such sum, not being less than one shilling, as such Council or Board shall determine.

25 3. In any case wherein ~~a County Council or Highway Board~~ *any local authority* shall, in pursuance of the discretionary power by the proviso to section *two* of this Act conferred, have determined to permit the registration of dogs kept for either of the purposes therein mentioned at any reduced fee, every person claiming to register any dog at

Penalty for false declaration.

such reduced fee shall be required to sign a declaration in the form of the *First* Schedule hereto; and if any such declaration be false or untrue, the person wilfully making such false declaration shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding *twenty* pounds, or to imprisonment for any period not exceeding one month.

Penalty for non-registration by date fixed not to apply in certain cases.

4. Where any person, without having been summoned to enforce payment of the registration fee in respect of any dog in his possession or following, shall have paid such registration fee after the time limited for such registration, he shall be exempted from the penalty imposed by the said Act for not effecting such registration within the proper time, and shall not be liable to be summoned for the payment of such penalty. But this section shall not operate as a bar to the conviction or fining of any person against whom an information shall have been laid prior to the payment of such registration fee.

New Clauses.

Proviso to section 13 of "Dog Registration Act, 1880."

5. Provided that any dog, instead of being destroyed as aforesaid, may be seized and kept by the police or by any one duly authorized by the local authority, and if not claimed and the expenses of the dog's keep paid by the owner within *seven* days from the time of such seizure, may be sold and disposed of to any person, and such person shall thereupon become the lawful owner of the same; and the proceeds of any such sale as aforesaid shall be paid into the funds of the local authority.

This proviso shall be read as a proviso to section thirteen of "The Dog Registration Act, 1880."

Registration label may be fixed to any collar.

6. Whenever a dog is duly registered under the said Act, it shall be lawful for the owner to affix the registration-label obtained from the registration office on any dog-collar other than one obtained from the said office.

Repeal.

7. The Acts enumerated in the *Second* Schedule hereto are hereby repealed to the extent specified in such Schedule.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

"DOG REGISTRATION ACT 1880 AMENDMENT ACT, 1882."

Application to register at Reduced Fee.
