A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to further amend "The Dog Registration Act, 1880." THE BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Dog Registration Act Short Title.

Amendment Act, 1890."

2. For the purposes of this Act the words "shepherd" and Interpretation. "driver" shall respectively mean any person acting in the capacity

of a shepherd or as a driver of sheep or cattle.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Dog Registration Act, 1880," or "The Dog Registration Act Amendment Act,
1882," any shepherd or driver, upon making the declaration prescribed
in the Schedule hereto, shall be entitled to have any dog or number
of dogs not exceeding three registered upon payment of a fee not
15 exceeding two shillings and sixpence each; and, if any such declaration
be false or untrue, the person wilfully making such false declaration
shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty pounds, or to imprisonment for any period not exceeding one month.
