A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest certain Lands in the City of Dunedin, formerly held by the Superintendent of the Province of Otago in trust for the Inhabitants of the said City, in the Corporation of the City of Dunedin, and to provide for the Management of such Lands.

WHEREAS by "The Otago University Site Exchange Act, 1875," the Superintendent of the Province of Otago, in whom the parcel of land described in the Schedule to this Act was then vested, was authorized to vest the management of the said parcel of land in the Corporation of the City of Dunedin and its successors as a corporate body, in exchange for certain other lands in the said City of Dunedin, which are described in the Second Schedule of the said Act: And whereas the management of the said parcel of land was never vested in the Corporation of the City of Dunedin under the provisions of the said Act, and it is expedient that the said parcel of land should be vested in the Corporation of the City of Dunedin, upon trust for purposes of public utility to the said city and its inhabitants, and with the powers of management and administration hereinafter contained:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Dunedin Reserves Act, 1877."
2. Sections three and four of "The Otago University Site Exchange Act, 1875," shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
3. Immediately upon the passing of this Act the parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto shall vest in the Corporation of the City of Dunedin and its successors, for an estate of inheritance in fee-simple, in trust for purposes of public utility for the City of Dunedin and its inhabitants.

Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Otago, in the Colony of New Zealand, containing by admeasurement seven (7) acres two (2) roods and three (3) poles, more or less, situate in the City of Dunedin, being part of area formerly set apart for Cemetery Reserve on the map of the said city. Bounded by a line commencing at a point in Rattray Street one hundred and sixty-two and seven-tenths (162·7) links distant from the southern corner of the said reserve, and proceeding thence in a west-north-westerly direction along Rattray Street and the Town Belt bearing one hundred and eleven degrees thirty-eight minutes forty-two seconds ($111^{\circ} 38' 42''$), one thousand six hundred and ninety-two and eight-tenths (1692·8) links; thence in an east-north-easterly direction along the Town Belt bearing sixty-six degrees thirty-eight minutes forty-two seconds ($66^{\circ} 38' 42''$), one thousand five hundred and sixty-seven (1567) links; thence in a south-south-westerly direction bearing twenty-five degrees thirty-four minutes forty-two seconds ($25^{\circ} 34' 42''$), three hundred and eighty-nine (389) links; thence in an east-south-easterly direction bearing one hundred and eleven degrees forty-three minutes forty-two seconds ($111^{\circ} 43' 42''$), one hundred and sixty and two-tenths (160·2) links; thence in a south-south-westerly direction bearing twenty-one degrees thirty-eight minutes forty-two seconds ($21^{\circ} 38' 42''$), two hundred and seventy (270) links, to main district road; thence in a southerly direction along the main district road eighty-two and five-tenths (82·5) links; thence in an east-south-easterly direction bearing one hundred and eleven degrees forty-three minutes forty-two seconds ($111^{\circ} 43' 42''$), five hundred and fifty-six (556) links, to Arthur Street; thence in a south-south-westerly direction along Arthur Street one hundred and eighty and seven-tenths (180·7) links; thence in a west-north-westerly direction bearing one hundred and eleven degrees thirty-eight minutes forty-two seconds ($111^{\circ} 38' 42''$), one hundred and sixty-two and seven-tenths (162·7) links; thence in a south-south-westerly direction bearing twenty-six degrees thirty-eight minutes forty-two seconds ($26^{\circ} 38' 42''$), two hundred and thirty-six and five tenths (236·5) links, to the starting point, and intersected by the main district road one hundred (100) links wide.
