1. Short Title	

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Disputes Tribunals Act 1988

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 5 **1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Disputes Tribunals Amendment Act 1995, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Disputes Tribunals Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

23. Rules—Section 60 (2) of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (g), the following paragraph:

“(ga) The giving of evidence to Tribunals, including the giving of evidence *(by video link or telephone conference)* from a distance (for example by video link or telephone conference).” 5
