A BILL INTITULED

An Act to legalize the Marriage of a Man with the Title. Sister of his Deceased Wife.

HEREAS it is expedient to permit the marriage of a man with Preamble the sister of his deceased wife:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 5 as follows:

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Deceased Wife's Short Title. Sister Marriage Act, 1874."

2. All marriages which shall subsequently to the passing of this Marriage with Act be solemnized or contracted within the Colony of New Zealand 10 between any person and his deceased wife's sister shall be deemed to be and are hereby declared valid, any law against such marriages notwithstanding.
