A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to the Nomination of Candidates for the Representation of the People in the House of Representatives. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Electoral Act Amendment Act (No. 1), 1903." Short Title.

10 2. Section ninety-nine of "The Electoral Act, 1902," is hereby amended by striking out the word "man" where the same occurs in paragraph one thereof, and substituting the word "person" in lieu thereof. Section ninety-nine amended.
