Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act, 1928,
and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education
Amendment Act, 1919. Short Title.

2. Subsection two of section fifteen of the Education Amendment
10 Act, 1919, is hereby repealed. Repeal.
