An Act to amend the Education Act, 1914. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority 5 of the same, as follows:—

2. Section two of the Education Amendment Act, Section 2 of 1932–33. is hereby amended by inserting, subsection eight, the following new subsection:-

3. (1) Section four of the Education Amendment

(b) By omitting from paragraph (d) all words after the words "any position held by him", and substituting the words "at a date specified in the regulations where the salary attached 15 to that position by any regulations coming into force after the date so specified is less than the maximum salary and allowances receivable by him for that position on the date so specified ".

(2) The said section four is hereby further amended

by adding thereto the following new paragraph:

"(f) Providing for the fixing of rentals teachers' residences, the method of payment of such rentals, and the conditions of 25 occupancy of such residences."
