1. Short Title 2. Meaning of "contractor"

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Electoral Act 1956

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 5 as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Electoral Amendment Act 1958, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electoral Act 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

- 10 **2. Meaning of "contractor"**—(1) Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) By inserting in the definition of the term "contractor" in subsection one, after the words "any contract" where they first occur, the words "or contracts":
- 15 (b) By omitting from the same definition the words "above the sum of", and substituting the words "amounting in the aggregate to more than the sum of".

(2) Section two of the principal Act is hereby further amended as from the commencement of that Act by omitting from the proviso to subsection two the words "by way of fees, salary, or allowances", and substituting the words "of one or more of such bodies by way of fees, salary, or allowances 5 amounting in the aggregate to more than two hundred pounds in any one financial year".
