A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Electricians Act 1952

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
5 as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Electricians
Amendment Act 1959, and shall be read together with and
deemed part of the Electricians Act 1952 (hereinafter referred
to as the principal Act).

10 2. **Abolition of inspection fees**—(1) Section twenty-four of
the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from sub-
section two the words “on payment of the prescribed fee”.

(2) Regulation forty of the Electricians Registration Regu-
lations 1956 is hereby consequentially revoked.
