Title 1. Short Title 2. Amending provision as to teaching in public schools

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Education Act 1914

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act 1960 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act 1914 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 2. Amending provision as to teaching in public schools—Section fifty-six of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from subsection four the words "and the teaching shall be entirely of a secular character".
