An Act to amend the Electric-power Boards Act, 1918.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Electric-power Boards Amend- short Title. ment Act, 1919, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electric-power Boards Act, 1918 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.)
