A BILL INTITULED

An Act to provide for the Constitution of the Borough of East- Tible. bourne.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the special area described in the Preamble. 5 Schedule hereto should be constituted a borough:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same. as follows:

- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Eastbourne Borough Short Title. **10** Act, 1905."
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Municipal Cor- Eastbourne porations Act, 1900," the special area comprised in the Schedule Borough. hereto is hereby constituted a borough, under the name of Eastbourne, the boundaries thereof being particularly defined in the said 15 Schedule, and shall have all the powers conferred upon a borough under "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1900," and any amendments thereof.
- 3. The provisions contained in sections thirty-one, thirty-two, Sections 31 to 35 of The Counties Act, 1886." "The Counties Act, thirty-three, thirty-four, and thirty-five of "The Counties Act, 1886," 20 providing for the determination of matters referred to therein, shall mutandis, to apply. apply, mutatis mutandis, to the new authorities created under this Act.

4. This Act shall come into force on the first day of April, one Date of commencethousand nine hundred and six.
