A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to constitute the Eketahuna County.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Eketahuna County Act, 1896."

Short Title.

2. The Eketahuna County is hereby constituted, and shall comprise that portion of the Wairarapa North County particularly described in the Schedule hereto; and the boundaries of the Wairarapa North County are hereby altered accordingly.

Constitution of Eketahuna County.

3. From and after the coming into operation of this Act, and during the subsistence of the county hereby constituted, no local body or authority other than the County Council shall, within the limits of the said county, be created or exercise any jurisdiction or authority over any roads, or over or in relation to any matter or thing in respect of which jurisdiction is conferred upon a County Council under the provisions of "The Counties Act, 1886," or any amendment thereof, or otherwise.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that area in the County of Wairarapa North comprised in the Eketahuna Road District. Bounded towards the north by the Pahiatua County; towards the east by the Alfredton outlying district, in the Wairarapa North County; towards the south by the Mauriceville Road District; and towards the west by the Wirokino Road District.
