Title. 1. Short Title.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to constitute the Eketahuna County. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-**5** lows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Eketahuna County Act, Short Title. 1898."

2. The Eketahuna County is hereby constituted, and shall Constitution of comprise that portion of the Wairarapa North County particularly Eketahuna County. 10 described in the Schedule hereto; and the boundaries of the Wairarapa North County are hereby altered accordingly.

3. From and after the coming into operation of this Act, and Jurisdiction of during the subsistence of the county hereby constituted, no local body or authority other than the County Council shall, within

15 the limits of the said county, be created or exercise any jurisdiction or authority over any roads, or over or in relation to any matter or thing in respect of which jurisdiction is conferred upon a County Council under the provisions of "The Counties Act, 1886," or any amendment thereof, or otherwise.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in the County of Wairarapa North comprised in the Eketahuna Road District, Alfredton Riding Outlying District, and Akitio Road District, as existing at the end of June, 1898, commencing at Arawaru Trig. Station, and going easterly. Bounded generally towards the north and north-west by the Pahiatua County, and again towards the north by the Hawke's Bay Provincial District; towards the east by the sea; towards the south by the Castlepoint, Upper Taueru, and Mauriceville Road Districts; towards the west by the Wirokino Road District and Oroua County to the point of commencement.
