A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to alter the Boundaries of the Hawke's Bay and Auckland Land Districts respectively. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The East Coast Lands Act, 1881." Short Title.
It shall come into operation from and after the *thirty-first* day of *March*, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-*two*.

2. The Hawke's Bay Land District and the Auckland Land District, as Districts altered.
constituted under "The Land Act, 1877," are hereby altered as follows :—

10 The boundaries of the Land District of Hawke's Bay shall be extended, to comprise within its limits that portion of territory within the Provincial District of Auckland which is described in the Schedule hereto.

The boundaries of the Land District of Auckland shall be limited, to comprise the Provincial District of Auckland, excepting the part thereof hereinbefore
15 described as forming part of the Land District of Hawke's Bay.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that territory bounded on the South by the 39th parallel of south latitude, from Boat Harbour to the boundary-line between the Meridional Survey Circuits of the Bay of Plenty and Poverty Bay; on the West-north-west by the said line to the sea; on the North and East by the coast line to the starting-point at Boat Harbour.
