### A BILL INTITULED

An Act to change the Purpose of a Recreation Reserve at Eketahuna, Title. by converting the same into a Cemetery Reserve.

WHEREAS the land in the Schedule attached hereto was set apart Preamble. 5 on the second day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, as a recreation reserve, and the inhabitants are desirous of changing the same to a cemetery reserve:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 10 as follows:—
