A BILL INTITULED

An Act to confer Additional Powers upon the Ellesmere Domain Title. Board.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:--

1. This Act may be cited as the Ellesmere Domain Board Short Title.

Empowering Act, 1909.

2. The Ellesmere Domain Board may, out of funds at its Power to purchase 10 disposal derived from the domain under its control, purchase in the purposes for name of His Most Gracious Majesty the King one or more piece or Southbridge and pieces of land for public recreation purposes for the Township of Doyleston or either of such places. Southbridge and the Township or Village of Doyleston, or, at the discretion of the Board, for either of such places, excluding the other 15 of them.

3. Subject to the provisions of section two hereof, the Board Power to purchase may from time to time, out of the funds and in the manner prescribed in such section, acquire one or more piece or pieces of land purposes. for public recreation purposes for such township or townships, village 20 or villages, situated in the district served by the Board, as the Board in its discretion may hereafter from time to time decide.

4. All land purchased by the Board under the provisions of this Land purchased Act shall, on being conveyed to the King, be subject to the Public Fublic Reserves and Reserves and Domains Act, 1908, and shall be under the control of Domains Act, 1908. 25 the Ellesmere Domain Board.
