An Act to define the Hours of Labour within the Colony of New Title. Zealand.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Eight Hours Act, 1885." Short Title.

2. From and after the first day of January, one thousand eight Eight hours a day's hundred and eighty-six, eight hours shall, unless where there is a work and forty-eight hours a week's work. contract in writing to the contrary, constitute a day's work, and 10 forty-eight hours a week's work.
