A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to continue the Operation of certain Expiring Enactments Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Expiring Laws Continuance short Title. Act, 1921-22.

2. (1.) The enactments mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall Duration of certain continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen expiring enactments
