AN ACT to further extend Protection to Young Persons engaged in Labour. Title.
BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

- 5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Employment of Females and Others
Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1882." Short Title.
2. This Act shall be read together with "The Employment of Females Act,
1881" (hereinafter called "the said Act"). Incorporation with
original Act.
- 10 3. In this Act, if not inconsistent with the context, "employ" shall also
include delivery of goods, parcels, or messages in the furtherance and by way of
trade or in the furtherance or for purposes of gain. Extended
interpretation.
4. No person shall employ any female, young person, or child at any time
between the hours of six in the afternoon and eight in the morning, or for more
than eight hours in any one day. Section five of the said Act is hereby
15 repealed. Hours of employment
prescribed.
5. Nothing in this Act shall be deemed or taken to prevent— Act not applicable in
certain cases.
- (1.) The employment of females in retail places of business where goods are
exposed for sale on Saturdays only, or on the day immediately
preceding any public holiday, up to eight o'clock in the evening.
- 20 Provided that females so exceptionally employed shall not be employed for
more than eight hours in any one day. Subsection one of section ten of the
said Act is hereby repealed.
6. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act and of the said Breaches of Act.
Act, any person duly authorized, as in the said Act provided, may enter and
25 inspect any factory at any time if he shall have good reason to believe that the
provisions of this Act or of the said Act are being infringed.
