A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Employment of Females and Others Act, 1881," and "The Employment of Females and Others Act Amendment Act, 1885." Title.

5 WHEREAS the appointing of one half-holiday from two o'clock in the afternoon on only one day in the week for all classes of workers, being female young persons and children, has been found unsuitable : Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

10 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Employment of Females and Others Acts Amendment Act, 1889." Short Title.

15 2. A special order made under section three of "The Employment of Females and Others Act, 1881," and the "Employment of Females and Others Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1885," may from time to time provide and appoint separate working-days in the week on which different classes or sets of workers, being females, young persons, and children, referred to in such section, shall respectively have a holiday from two o'clock in the afternoon. Different half-holidays in the week may be fixed for various classes of workers.

20 3. A special order made in accordance with the provisions of this Act shall have in all other respects the effect of a special order made under the said section three of "The Employment of Females and Others Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1885."
