- AN ACT to amend "The Employment of Females and Others Act, Title. 1881," and "The Employment of Females and Others Act Amendment Act, 1885.'
- 5 WHEREAS the appointing of one half-holiday from two o'clock in Preamble. the afternoon on only one day in the week for all classes of workers, being female young persons and children, has been found unsuitable :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 10 follows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Employment of Females Short Title. and Others Acts Amendment Act, 1890."

2. A special order made under section three of "The Employment Different halfof Females and Others Act, 1881," and the "Employment of Females week may be fixed

- 15 and Others Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1885," may from time to time for various classes provide and appoint separate working-days in the week on which different classes or sets of workers, being females, young persons, and children, referred to in such section, shall respectively have a holiday from one o'clock in the afternoon.
- 3. A special order made in accordance with the provisions of this Regarding special 20Act shall have in all other respects the effect of a special order made order. under the said section three of "The Employment of Females and Others Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1885."
