ENGINEERS REGISTRATION AMENDMENT.

Title. | 2. Section 6 of principal Act amended.
1. Short Title.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Engineers Registration Act, 1924. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Engineers Registration Amendment Act, 1928, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Engineers Registration Act, 1924 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act"). Short Title.

2. Subsection one of section six of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (c) thereof, the following paragraph:— Section 6 of principal Act amended.

15 " (d) Being a licensed or registered surveyor, shall satisfy the Board that he has had practical experience in engineering as part of his practice as a surveyor, whether such practice has been by him on his own account or otherwise howsoever, and who makes application for registration within twelve months after the commencement of this Act. A certificate under the seal of the Surveyors Board that any person is a licensed or registered surveyor and that he has had practical experience in engineering as part of his practice as a surveyor shall be conclusive evidence in support of any such application of the facts therein stated." 20
