Validation of emergency regulations. 4. All emergency regulations heretofore made under 5 the principal Act (including regulations made under the joint authority of that Act and any other Act) shall for all purposes be deemed, as from the making thereof, to have been made with full power and authority, and to be and to have been valid and of full effect; and 10 the powers, rights, duties, and liabilities of all persons in respect of all things done or suffered, whether before or after the passing of this Act, shall be determined accordingly.
