A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to Amend the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939. Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority 5 of the same, as follows:---

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Emergency short Title Regulations Amendment Act, 1948, and shall be read and together with and deemed part of the Emergency Regu-1939, No. 8 lations Act, 1939 (hereinafter referred to as the principal 10 Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-eight.

2. (1) The emergency regulations specified in the Revocation of *First* Schedule to this Act are hereby revoked.

4. (1) The emergency regulations specified in the Third Schedule to this Act, and all emergency regulations 10 made under that Act and in force at the commencement of this Act, unless they are sooner revoked by the Governor-General in Council or by any Act, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-nine, and shall then expire. 15
