

EMERGENCY REGULATIONS AMENDMENT BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THIS Bill extends the duration of the remaining emergency regulations for a further year, that is, to the end of 1952.

The Bill revokes the regulations specified in the First Schedule, and repeals the references to the regulations specified in the Second Schedule, which have already been revoked.

The regulations that remain in force are specified in the Third Schedule.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to Amend the Emergency Regulations Act 1939. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Emergency Regulations Amendment Act 1951, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Emergency Regulations Act 1939 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title. 1939, No. 8

2. (1) The emergency regulations specified in the First Schedule to this Act are hereby revoked as from the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-one. Revocation of certain emergency regulations.

(2) The Second Schedule to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act 1947 is hereby amended as from the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-one, by repealing so much thereof as relates to the regulations hereby revoked. 1947, No. 66

Emergency regulations revoked by other enactments. 1947, No. 66

3. The Second Schedule to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act 1947 (as amended by the last preceding section) is hereby further amended by repealing so much thereof as relates to the regulations specified in the Second Schedule to this Act (being regulations that have been revoked by other enactments). 5

4. The emergency regulations specified in the Third Schedule to this Act, unless they are sooner revoked by the Governor-General in Council or by any Act, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-two, and shall then expire. 10

5. The Emergency Regulations Amendment Act 1950 is hereby repealed.
