EMERGENCY REGULATIONS AMENDMENT BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill extends the duration of the remaining emergency regulations for a further year, that is, to the end of 1952.

The Bill revokes the regulations specified in the First Schedule, and repeals the references to the regulations specified in the Second Schedule, which have already been revoked.

The regulations that remain in force are specified in the Third Schedule.
