A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Emergency Regulations Act 1939. Title: BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority 5 of the same, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Emergency short Title. Regulations Amendment Act 1952, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Emergency Regu- 1939, No. 8 lations Act 1939 (hereinafter referred to as the principal 10 Act).
 - 2. (1) The emergency regulations specified in the Revocation of First Schedule to this Act are hereby revoked as from certain the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and regulations. fifty-two.

(2) The Second Schedule to the Emergency Regu- 1947, No. 66 15 lations Continuance Act 1947 is hereby amended as from the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-two, by repealing so much thereof as relates to the regulations hereby revoked.

Repeal. 1951, No. 63 3. The emergency regulations specified in the Second Schedule to this Act, unless they are sooner revoked by the Governor-General in Council or by any Act, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-three, and shall then expire.
