# EMERGENCY REGULATIONS AMENDMENT BILL

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill extends the duration of the remaining emergency regulations for a further year, that is, to the end of 1956.

The Bill revokes the regulations specified in the First Schedule, and repeals the references to the regulations specified in the Second Schedule, which have already been revoked or are being revoked by other enactments.

The regulations that are to remain in force are specified in the Third Schedule.

### A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Emergency Regulations Act 1939. Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority 5 of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Emergency Regulations Short Title. Amendment Act 1955, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Emergency Regulations Act 1939 1939, No. 8 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. (1) The emergency regulations specified in the First Revocation of Schedule to this Act are hereby revoked as from the certain thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-regulations.

(2) The Second Schedule to the Emergency Regula- 1947, No. 66 15 tions Continuance Act 1947 is hereby amended as from the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, by repealing so much thereof as relates to the regulations hereby revoked.

3. The Second Schedule to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act 1947 (as amended by section two of this Act) is hereby further amended by repealing so much thereof as relates to the regulations specified in the Second Schedule to this Act (being regulations that have been revoked by other enactments).

4. The emergency regulations specified in the Third Schedule to this Act, unless they are sooner revoked by the Governor-General in Council or by any Act, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nine- 10

teen hundred and fifty-six, and shall then expire.

5. The Emergency Regulations Amendment Act 1954 is hereby repealed.
